2019 Nomination Guidelines

The Catholic Professional & Business Club's Leading with Faith Award honors people for living their faith in the work-a-day world. Catholic owners, executives or individuals with supervisory responsibility – from the business world and nonprofits – are eligible for this special award.

The 2019 awards will be presented to individuals who have influenced the workplace through business practices that reflect the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Church and who share of themselves in their parish and/or community.

The Leading With Faith Nomination Guidelines are outlined below. When considering individuals to nominate for the Awards, consider contacting co-workers and acquaintances to collect collaborating input for the submission.

Use additional pages, as necessary.

1. The individual's business practices on a day-to-day basis are grounded in the faith and the person's words, presence and actions demonstrate the Gospel message in the workplace. For example:
 - a) How does this individual interact or treat other co-workers, customers, or associates?

 - b) How does this individual handle stressful situations or adversity?

 - c) How has this individual mentored or inspired others in the workplace to better themselves?

 - d) How has this individual used words or actions to recognize the human dignity of others at work?

 - e) Is there a specific memory or story of this individual that demonstrates their commitment to live out the faith in the workplace?

2. The individual is seen by peers, subordinates and acquaintances as being fair and ethical in business dealings with customers, vendors and employees. Is there an ethical dilemma/adversity this person has faced in the work environment? How did this person react?

3. The individual is recognized as or known to be a practicing Catholic and encourages and inspires others to follow Christ.

4. The individual is active in parish and archdiocesan-activities / initiatives, or volunteers in community-based organizations.

Include any additional information about how the nominee serves the community. Include his/her personal qualities and background, special interests, family or education that supports your nomination. *Additional pages and information supporting this nomination may be attached to this application, as necessary.*
